Students who take TEC come from a wide range of backgrounds. Some students have just completed or are near the end of their Education degree in their home country. Most, but not all, TEC students have no experience teaching children, but they might have experience volunteering with children. Some students just want a different way of studying English and some students want some ideas on how they could teach their own children—in the future. A lot of students who finish this TEC course like to continue their studies by taking a TESL course for teaching adults. This TEC course complements further study.

During this course you will:

- Learn how to teach all the skills and create different types of lessons and activities to make teaching more enjoyable
- Learn about Classroom Management skills, learning styles, the child-centered classroom, how to use a storybook and video, and much more
- Use and improve your own English skills
- Gain confidence teaching your classmates and real children
- Put into practice all that you have learned throughout the course in the final practicum
