Included with registration

Class features

- 4.5 hours per day of English classes in our English For Teens program for 11–14 years; five hours per day in our Power English program for 15+ years.
- Native-speaker teachers with extensive qualifications and experience in teaching students of all ages and nationalities.
- Focus on Fluency: techniques and activities to make learning English fun!
- Materials for classes.
- Maximum 14 students to a class.

Activities include

- Daily sport, social, cultural and sightseeing activities as in the calendar.
- An experienced Canadian Activity Coordinator to lead Stewart College activities.
- Transportation and entry fees for all group members.

HOMESTAY

You can choose to join our homestay program while you study at our school.

- Our host families are Canadian, with at least one parent being a native speaker of English. English is the first language spoken at home.
- There may be up to two other students staying with your host family; they will be the same sex as you, and will speak a different language to you.
- Students aged 11–12 registering for homestay will only be accepted in pairs or as part of a group. Individual students this age cannot be accepted into our homestay program as individuals.
- Transport to/from school is included for students aged 11–12 (by car) and 13–14 (by bus). Families are usually 30 minutes or less from downtown by bus.
- Homestay includes three meals a day plus snacks (packed lunch on school days)
- Free wifi at home (with your own devices).
- All students 11–18 years old need a guardian or custodian in Victoria if they are not accompanied by their parents. We can provide this service if needed.
